

Holy Cross Lutheran Church Scholarship Application

In 1999, Mr. Cliff Moyer gave a substantial gift in memory of his wife, Martha, to support “outreach to the community.” This gift, along with similar gifts, is maintained in the Holy Cross Endowment Fund. This fund is used to benefit the missions of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, the missions of Holy Cross Lutheran Church, other worthy causes, and scholarships for members of Holy Cross Lutheran Church.

The purpose of this Scholarship is to remind the recipient of the love of Christ and their church family with the hope that it will encourage higher education, personal growth, witness of faith in Christ and service to others.

Scholarship Requirements

1. Applicant must be a current, participating member of Holy Cross Lutheran Church.
2. Applicant must be attending (or provide proof of admission) to a college, university, or other institute of higher learning for the eligible spring or fall academic semester.
3. Applicant provides a short statement that covers the following points, as applicable:
 - a. Likelihood of academic success (grades in college and high school, athletics, extra-curricular activities)
 - b. Financial need
 - c. Service to others (as part of youth group, church, or independently)
 - d. Any other facts or information that lets the board know that the scholarship will be well used.
4. Letters of recommendation will be considered but are not required.

Application and personal statement should be received by the church office no later than the date specified by the Endowment Board.
